Capital Improvement Reserve Fund

The Greenwood Forest HOA
Board of Directors has established
a capital improvement reserve
fund. The purpose of the fund
is to ensure that future capital
improvement funds will be
available when needed.

The initial funding amount was \$40,000. An additional \$2,500 per month will be added to the reserve account as funds become available.

The reserve can only be used in the event the HOA's current capital improvement needs exceed its current improvement budget.

This will help to solidify the future financial integrity of your neighborhood homeowner's accociation, so it will be able to maintain Greenwood Forest's clubhouse facility.

GREENWOOD FOREST HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION POOL POLICIES AND RULES

- 1. No Pets within the pool facility
- 2. Appropriate swimwear only. No cut-offs or colored t-shirts.
- 3. Must present pool tags and sign in.
- Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. 4.
- Please shower before entering the pool.
- 6. One long whistle from the lifeguards means to exit the pools.
- All children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, 18 or older.
- A swim test **will** be required to ensure safety.
- 9. No running
- 10. No horseplay
- 11. No ball playing in the pool or pool area
- 12. No loud or offensive language, behavior, or music.
- 13. Admission to the pool may be denied to anyone with open skin abrasions, colds, coughs, contagious infections or bandaged wounds.
- 14. No smoking within the pool facility.
- 15. Pool toys must be approved by the lifeguards.
- 16. No electrical devices are permitted in pool area.
- 17. No food or beverage allowed in the pool. Members should take care to clear away all trash when leaving the pool area.
- 18. No alcoholic beverages
- 19. No glass containers.
- 20. Diving in designated areas only
- 21. Do not distract or talk to the lifeguards unless it's an emergency.
- 22. Greenwood Forest Homeowners Association is not responsible for items lost or left in the pool area.
- 23. Violation of pool rules may result in loss of pool privileges
- 24. No loud or offensive language, behavior or music
- 25. The Lifeguards have ultimate authority to interpret and enforce the rules.

BABY POOL RULES

- Lifeguards are not responsible for the baby pool.
- Parent and/or guardian (18 year old minimum) are responsible for their children and must not leave them unattended.
- No disposable diapers. Rubber swim pants only.
- 4. No diving

DIVING BOARD RULES

- Only one person allowed on board or steps at a time.
- 2. No swimming in diving area while diving board in use.
- 3. One bounce only
- No diving straight down or off sides of board
- **DO NOT** dive until the pool area is clear. 5.
- Back dives are prohibited.

POOL GUEST POLICIES

- Resident/member must be at least 12 years old to bring a guest. 1.
- 2. Guest fees must be paid at time of entry.
- 3. We accept exact change only
- 4. A maximum of 5 guests allowed at one time.
- 5. Residents are responsible for their guests at all times.
- 6. Residents must sign-in their guests at guard shack.
- 7. Guests must adhere to all general pool rules.

SUMMER TIME WATER SAFETY

Now that the heat is here and swimming pool usage will soon be in full swing, CESD would like to remind everyone to be careful in and around bodies of water. DON'T TAKE WATER SAFETY FOR GRANTED!

Drowning is the leading cause of injury or death for young children ages 1 to 4. Nationwide, **three**

children die every day

as a result of drowning. But you can help to prevent accidental drowning. Here are some tips: **Fence it off.** Install a four-sided isolation fence, with self-closing and self-latching gates, around backyard swimming pools. This can help keep children away from the area when a parent cannot supervise them. Pool fences should completely separate the house and play area from the pool.

Make life jackets a "must." If you plan on visiting natural bodies of water, make sure life jackets are worn. Even if your child is a good swimmer in

a swimming pool, it doesn't mean that he/she won't encounter something in a natural body of water that could drown them.

Bathtubs can be dangerous too! Remember that a child, especially babies, can drown in only 1 inch of water. Bathing in bathtubs are a regular household routine but can turn deadly very quickly. Never leave a baby in a bathtub unsupervised, even for what you think is "just a minute".

Learn CPR. Learn cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and get recertified every two years. CPR can help a child stay alive with little or no brain damage. For Cypress Creek EMS CPR classes visit www.ccems.com/education/cpr-first-aid-schedule/ for more info.

Be on the look-out. Adults watching kids near water should avoid distracting activities like playing cards, reading books, or talking on the phone. For more information about all kinds of child safety, visit www. cdc.gov/safechild.

There is an excellent deed restriction standard that our HOA adopted and this standard has worked very well for our subdivision for many years. The maintained beautiful homes in Greenwood benefit all of us. However, there is a growing concern over how some of our homes are currently being maintained. Our HOA has a part time employee, Denise Delmedico, working directly with home owners concerning these standard guidelines. She is available to assist you with any questions or concerns about your home and the established policies of our Greenwood Forest HOA. She can be reached during business hours Monday through Thursday at our club office on Champion Forest Drive. She is here to help you.

All conversations are confidential and your privacy will be maintained.

The vast majority of our residents do care how their property is maintained. However, we do have some residents who have no apparent interest in maintaining their property's appearance. My message to these few homeowners is that your lack of concern and interest is not acceptable to our HOA or to your neighbors. Your property doesn't have to be a "showpiece home" but must meet a basic standard that everyone around you expects. Please take some pride in the home that you live in as do the neighbors around you.

There are some actions that our local HOA can and will take regarding home owners, and or renters, who willfully ignore these guidelines and their surrounding neighbors. Please contact Denise or me directly should you have questions concerning deed restrictions and your property.

SOLICITORS

There have been recent concerns about the presence of some less than professional solicitors in our neighborhood. Contrary to what many believe, solicitors are not against the law here. Our signs saying "No Solicitors" are a warning that solicitors aren't welcome, but constables have no authority over soliciting. However, if a resident reports a solicitor's behavior is suspicious – such as soliciting late at night or offering a suspicious story, etc. – then our constable has probable cause to stop and question their reason for being in the neighborhood. As an example, a few years ago a resident called the constable's office to report a "furniture" salesman was knocking on doors and offering a story that didn't seem quite right. Our constables stopped and questioned the person resulting in his arrest for multiple out-of-state felony warrants. Bottom line: Never hesitate to call our constable office -281-376-3472 – when you have a concern.

SIGNS

Comments continue about the mess that often remains when residents and non-residents post signs advertising garage sales, estate sales, lost/found pets, etc. and then fail to remove the signage when the event is over or the pet is found. It bears noting that it is against the law in Texas to post signs in the right-of-way which includes street lights, stop signs, speed limit signs, etc. These signs are known as "Bandit Signs" and can carry a fine of \$500 to \$1000 per day per sign when pursued. Enforcement of this law is unlikely in our subdivision unless the circumstances are extreme, but common courtesy on the part of the person posting the signs would be helpful in keep-

ing our neighborhood beautiful. When the sale is over, pet recovered or a reasonable amount of time has passed, please remove the sign and any material used to attach it. Placing signs on STOP & SPEED LIMIT signs is a distraction and should not be done. Remnants of signs and the attaching material adorn many of the traffic signs and poles along our roadway and are not legal or attractive.
