Fire Department



Hurricane Season is here. BE PREPARED!

Before a Hurricane

- To begin preparing, you should build an emergency kit and make a family communications plan.
- Be sure trees and shrubs around your home are well trimmed so they are more wind resistant.
- Clear loose and clogged rain gutters and downspouts.
- Plan to bring in pets, all outdoor furniture, decorations, garbage cans, and anything else that is not tied down.
- Fuel your vehicles and generators.

During a Hurricane

- Listen to the radio, TV, or refer to trusted internet sites for information.
- Stay inside. Don't go outside unless absolutely necessary. If the eye passes over, don't get caught in the calm of the storm.
- Avoid windows and stay in the interior areas of your home.
- Ensure a supply of water for drinking as well as for sanitary purposes such as cleaning and flushing toilets. Fill the bathtub and other larger containers with water.
- Know that fire and emergency medical services may not respond until sustained winds are below 55 mph.

Neighborhood Safety Tips For Parents

Unfortunately no neighborhood is completely immune to crime. However, there are steps you can take to help keep your family and your neighborhood safe.

- Know where your children are. Have your children tell you or ask permission before leaving the house and give them a time to check in or be home. When possible, have them leave a phone number of where they will be.
- Help children learn important phone numbers. Have your children practice reciting their home phone number and address, and your work and cell phone numbers. If they have trouble memorizing these, write them down on a card and have them carry it at all times. Tell your children where you will be and the best way to reach you.
- Set limits on where your children can go in your neighborhood. Are there certain homes in your neighborhood that you don't want your children to go to?
- Get to know your children's friends. Meet their parents before letting your children to go to their home and keep a list of their phone numbers. If you can't meet their parents, call and talk to them. Ask what your children might do at their house and if they will be supervised.
- Choose a safe house in your neighborhood. Pick a neighbor's house where your children can go if they need help.
- Teach children to settle arguments with words, not fists. Role-play talking out problems, walking away from fist fights, and what to do when confronted with bullies.
- Work together with your neighbors. Watch out for suspicious and unusual behavior in your neighborhood. Get to know your neighbors and their children so you can look out for one another.

Scam of the Week: QuickBooks Used as Bait for a Quick Scam

An easy way for cybercriminals to get your attention is to claim that you owe a large amount of money. Pair this claim with a QuickBooks-themed phishing email and malicious malware, you get a dangerous cybersecurity threat.

The cybercriminals send a well-made spoof of a QuickBooks email that even includes an invoice number. The email message states that you owe over one-thousand dollars for the order but it gives no further details. Attached to the email is what appears to be an Excel file with the invoice number as the filename. The bad guys are hoping you'll open the attachment looking for more information. If you do open it, you'll actually be opening a dangerous piece of malware specially designed to target your financial and banking information. This malware can lead to unauthorized charges, wire transfers, and even data breaches.

Here's how you can stay safe from scams like this:

- Never click a link or download an attachment in an email that you were not expecting.
- Remember that bad guys can disguise anything, even file types.
- If you think the notification could be legitimate, navigate to the official QuickBooks website and log in to your account to confirm.

Stop, Look, and Think. Don't be fooled.


